2. The Local Agency agrees the payment of Federal funds will be limited to the amounts approved by the Federal Highway Administration in the Federal-Aid Project Agreement (PR-2)/Detail Estimate, or its modification (PR-2A) or the FNM-76, and accepts any increases in Local Agency Funds as shown on the Finance or Bid Letter or its modification as prepared by the Office of Local Programs.
3. This Program Supplement will be revised at a later date to include other phases of work.
4. This agreement supplements the Local Agency-State Master Agreement for Federal-Aid projects, with the understanding that all provisions of the 1991 Intermodal Surface Transportation Efficiency Act (ISTEA) apply.
5. The Local Agency will advertise, award and administer this project in accordance with the current Local Program Procedures or the new Local Programs Manual, when issued.
6. In executing this Program Supplemental Agreement, Local Agency hereby reaffirms the "Nondiscrimination Assurances" contained in the aforementioned Master Agreement for Federal-Aid Program.
7. 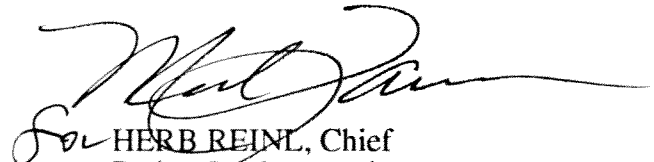
