Dear Mayor Foster:

With respect to the above-referenced applications, federal law prescribes that a time period of 60 days from the date AT&T filed the application or from a AT&T's response to a timely notice of incomplete application, if any, is considered a reasonable period of time for the City to act on the application, unless the time period to act is extended by mutual agreement between the City and AT&T. See 47 C.F.R. § 16003. AT&T submitted these applications on March 29, 2019. The City issued an untimely incomplete notice on April 24, 2019. Thus, under the applicable FCC regulation, the applicable deadline for review is May 28, 2019. AT&T understands that the City needs additional review time in order to process the application. Without agreeing that this is an appropriate reason for delay, and in an effort to work cooperatively with the City, AT&T offers this extension of the applicable shot clocks for these two applications. When countersigned, this letter will confirm agreement between the City and AT&T to toll the applicable time for review to and including June 28, 2019. The parties further agree that no limitations period for any claim related to the timing of the City's processing the application shall commence to run before June 28, 2019.
