THIRD AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT FOR THE PROVISION OF PROESSIONAL CONSULTING SERVICES

This third amendment ("Third Amendment") to the agreement to provide professional consulting services dated July 1, 2013, (the "Agreement"), by and between the City of Redlands, a municipal corporation ("City"), and LDM Associates, Inc. ("Consultant"), is made and entered into this 5th day of January, 2016.

RECITALS

WHEREAS, it is the desire of City and Consultant to amend their existing Agreement, specifically Article 1 - Section 1.4 - entitled "ENGAGEMENT OF CONSULTANT" and Article 3 - Section 3.1 entitled "PAYMENT AND NOTICE," thereby establishing an Agreement termination date and increasing Consultant's total compensation by Six Thousand Nine Hundred and Ninety Dollars (\$6,990.00) for the performance of certain additional Services;

NOW, THEREFORE, City and Consultant agree as follows:

AGREEMENT

Section 1.4 relating to the term of the Agreement is hereby added to read as follows:

"This Agreement shall terminate on December 31, 2016."

Section 2. Section 3.1 of the Agreement, entitled "PAYMENT AND NOTICE" is hereby amended to read as follows:

"The total compensation for Consultant's performance of the Services shall not exceed the amount of Fifty Thousand Six Hundred and Fifty Six Dollars (\$50,656.00)."

- Section 3. The Scope of Services of the Agreement are amended to include additional Federal labor compliance monitoring services as described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto.
- Section 4. All other provisions of the Agreement shall remain unchanged by the Third Amendment, and are in effect.
