## CONTRACT

This contract entered into this IrSt day of JULY. 1975, by and between the City of Redlands through its duly appointed, qualified and acting agent whose signature appears below, hereinafter called the City, and the State of California, acting through its duly appointed, qualified and acting Director of Employment Development Department, hereinafter called EDD.

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the effective and successful operation of the Center that an experienced employment service employee provide supervision and technical assistance.

MOW, THEREFORE, it is agreed that:

- 1. The term of this contract shall be July 1, 1975 through December 31, 1975.
- 2. EDD shall assign a qualified employee to the City's Employment Center from EDD's San Bernardino State Employment Center located at 1148 West Second Street, San Bernardino, California 92410.
- 3. The City shall reimburse EDD the cost of providing such service at the rate of \$7.70 per hour not to exceed the total amount of \$5,000.00. The City agrees to utilize such services for a minimum of four hours per day and for a minimum of 500 hours for the term of this contract.
- 4. The City shall retain the right to establish the hours the City Employment Center will operate on a daily and/or weekly basis. The City may supplement the services of the EDD employee by assigning other employees selected by the City either on a paid or volunteer basis as determined by the City.
- 5. EDD shall train and supervise other City Employment Service employees in the Employment Center activities.

- 6. City agrees to furnish suitable quarters, utilities and telephone service adequate and essential to the operations by the City Employment Center.
- 7. MED shall furnish suitable and adequate equipment for the Center including the necessary forms and office supplies related to the operations.
- 8. EDD shall furnish the City with activity reports as required and/or requested by the City.
- 9. At all times during the performance of this contract, the selected EDD employee(s) shall remain employee(s) of EDD and the State of California and shall be entitled to all benefits and privileges and are subject to all duties and obligations of such employment including the provisions of the Unemployment Insurance Code, Government Code, State Administrative Manual, Rules of the State Personnel Board and any Federal statutes, regulations or policies that apply to employees of the Department.
  - 10. This contract may be amended only in writing by the parties.
- 11. This contract may be terminated by either party upon ten days' written notice.
