In awarding, or agreeing to award the contract, the Local Agency agrees the payment of Federal Funds will be limited to the detail estimate amount approved by the Federal Highway Administration in the Federal-Aid Project Agreement (PR-2), or its modification (PR-2A), and accepts any increases in Local Agency contribution. 4. The City agrees to maintain the completed work during the two year evaluation period.
