

AGREEMENT FOR ELECTRIC POWER SERVICE NON-TRANSFERABLE

THIS AGREEMENT made by and between SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA EDISON COMPANY, a corporation hereinafter called the Company, and City of Redlands, hereinafter called the Consumer.

Witnesseth:

1. That it is agreed between the parties hereto as follows:
The Company agrees to furnish and the Consumer agrees to take, use and pay for electric energy from the Company's electric distributing system for a term of 3 years from the date when the Company connects its system to Consumer's premises, to be used for 12 months during the months from Jan to Jan inclusive, out of each period of twelve months of the term of this agreement, for the operation of electric Motor of total installed capacity of 5 horsepower, nominal rating. Said electric Motor to be used only for Alarm and located on the following described premises in the County of Los Angeles, State of California, more particularly described as follows, to-wit:

Cor. 5th & Central
Redlands

Said service is to be rendered under and according to Company's effective Rate Schedule No. 5-1 C. R. C.

No. 5-1 and Consumer agrees to accept and pay for said energy on the terms and conditions of such schedule, and in accordance with and subject to the effective rules and regulations of the Company applicable to said class of service under said schedule.

2. It is agreed between the parties hereto that the Consumer shall have the right to discontinue such service at the end of said term upon giving thirty (30) days' notice in writing thereof to the Company prior to the expiration of said term, and if the Consumer does not give such notice this agreement shall be deemed to continue from year to year after the expiration of said term, upon all the terms, conditions and agreements herein stated, with the right on the part of the Consumer to discontinue this agreement at the end of any such additional year upon giving to the Company thirty (30) days' notice in writing thereof prior to the expiration of such additional year.

3. The Consumer agrees to keep the transformers of said equipment disconnected from Company's lines when said equipment is not in actual operation.

4. This contract shall at all times be subject to such changes or modifications of the Railroad Commissioner of California as said Commissioner may from time to time direct in the exercise of its jurisdiction.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Consumer has duly executed this agreement and the Company has caused the same to be provisionally accepted by its Power Salesman; the 29 day of Dec, 1926, but the same shall not be binding upon the Company until after its approval on behalf of the Company endorsed thereon by its President or by an agent thereunto duly authorized by its Board of Directors:
