




I am pleased to inform you that your request for a renewal of your COPS MORE 96 grant has been approved. As you know, this funding is for the continued support of the civilians that you were awarded under your original COPS MORE 96 Award. We expect this renewal will enable you to maintain the level of redeployment outlined in your original grant.

As a result of this renewal, your grant period has been extended for an additional year. (Your new grant end date appears on the actual Renewal Award document). We understand that this may not be sufficient time to complete the full draw-down of renewal funds (as well as complete grant requirements under your original grant) and therefore you will be able to request an extension of your grant period at a later date.

Enclosed in this packet is your Grant Award, which you must sign and return to the COPS Office within 90 days to officially accept your grant. Failure to return the signed award document within the 90 day period, could result in withdrawal of the funding without further notice from the COPS Office.
