Historic Properties Survey

The City applied for and received a grant this year to continue the 1976 survey of historic properties. The State Office of Historic Preservation awarded Redlands \$9,000 for this project. The Redlands Area Historical Society, in a most unusual and laudatory move, desires to contribute \$5,000 in funds raised by their recent quilt project, and to also participate as volunteer field workers on the Advisory Review Committee. On motion of Councilman Martinez, seconded by Councilman DeMirjyn, an agreement between the City of Redlands and the Redlands Area Historical Society was approved. A Professional Services Contract for Preparation of a Historic Property Survey between the City of Redlands and AEGIS was also unanimously approved on motion of Councilman Martinez, seconded by Councilman DeMirjyn.

Mayor Beswick commended the Historic and Preservation Commissioners for their very hard work towards the historic survey. She expressed gratitude to members of Redlands Area Historical Society for their contribution and assistance on this survey.

Bid Call Fire Hydrants

On motion of Councilman Martinez, seconded by Councilman DeMirjyn, Council unanimously authorized the City Clerk to advertise for bids for the County Office of Community Development Project to install thirteen (13) fire hydrants at various locations as designated by the Fire Chief on the north side of the City.

Grant Deed

CDBG Agreement
