The Parking Authority for the City of Redlands was established on January 18, 1966 with the adoption of Resolution No. 2499 and further clarified by Resolution No. 2598, in accordance with the Parking Law of 1949.

The governing body of the Parking Authority is the City Council, with Mayor Burroughs elected as chairman at the time of organization.

4:00 P.M. on the third Tuesday of the month was set as the regular meeting time.

The Parking Authority meets for the first time this date, and is convened to receive a financial feasibility report prepared for the City by the firm of Stone and Youngberg regarding proposed parking projects financed by the issuance of revenue bonds.

Mr. Edward J. Hyland presented a comprehensive study of three proposed projects and outlined methods of financing.

The Authority discussed costs, turn-over rates, validation, capacity and potential income, and past experience. Following lengthy consideration, on motion of Mr. Cummings seconded by Mr. DeMirjyn, the report

was accepted by the Authority, and appreciation expressed for the work of Mr. Hyland and Mr. Zelles.

There being no further business, the Authority adjourned, on motion, at 5:30 P.M.
