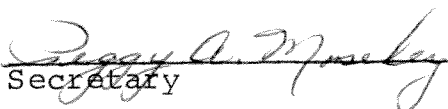
Mr. Shackelton gave a step-by-step description of the evolvement of the Riverside Redevelopment Agency beginning in 1967 through the present.

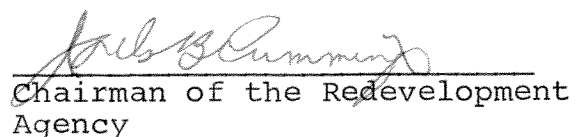
The Riverside concept envisions the mall as being of cultural, financial, and civic orientation without commercial or residential.
