Contract

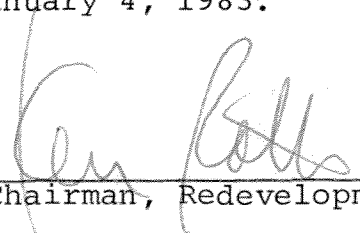
