 Budget

Director Quaschnick presented the Redevelopment Agency proposed budget for 1984-85 and indicated there was one change to be made on page 2. The change was to increase the amount to be reimbursed to the City for the Parking Bond by \$578,350.00 and changing the ending balance to \$1,452,694.00. Executive Director Holmes complimented Mr. Quaschnick for the first comprehensive budget prepared for the Agency. Town Center Manager.

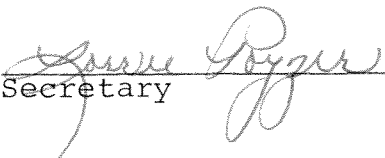
Mr. Quaschnick reported that Southern Pacific
