JOINT PUBLIC HEARING

Redlands Professional Properties A joint public hearing of the City Council and the Redevelopment Agency of the City of Redlands was continued and re-advertised for this time and place to consider for the purposes of redevelopment as a commercial development, the disposition and sale of real property to Redlands Professional Properties, Ltd. Chairman Beswick declared the meeting open as a public hearing on this matter. Acting Director McMenemy reported that Redlands Professional Properties, Ltd. has proposed to construct on the east side of North Sixth Street a one-story retail/office complex of approximately 22,000 square feet. Presently the lands are for sale on the open market and consequently no Disposition and Development Agreement is necessary at this time. It is recommended the proposed agreement and public hearing is discontinued. This recommendation was approved by AYE votes of all present and the proposed agreement and public hearing were discontinued.
