NEW BUSINESS

<u>First Time Home Buyers Program</u> - Michael Ponce, Executive Director, and Nicole Myerchin, of Neighborhood Housing Services explained their First Time Home Buyers Program. To qualify for this program, the potential buyers must fall within the program's income guidelines, be a first-time home buyer, perform 50 to 100 hours of community service in the City of Redlands, attend an educational workshop, and provide three percent of the down payment. Following discussion, Mr. Gil moved to support the First Time Home Buyers Program proposal as contained in the staff report and directed staff to develop an agreement with San Bernardino Neighborhood Housing Services for the development, implementation and administration of a First Time Home Buyers Program in the City of Redlands, with the understanding the agreement will contain provisions to provide this service for low-income level persons and include residency requirements. Motion seconded by Mr. Foster and carried unanimously.
