Ordinance No. 1469, which amends Article 407 of the Redlands Ordinance Code concerning fees for processing original and renewal applications for concealed weapons permits, was given second reading of the title and adopted on motion of Councilman Knudsen, seconded by Councilman DeMirjyn, by the following roll call vote, with notice being made that this is an emergency ordinance and will take effect immediately upon adoption:

Ordinance No. 1470, an ordinance of the City of Redlands amending those ordinances in the City Code which require municipal fees and authorizing these fees to be established by resolution of the Council, was given second reading of the title and adopted on motion of Councilman Sewall, seconded by Councilman Knudsen, with waiver of the reading of the ordinance in full, by the following roll call vote:

Resolution No. 2912, a resolution of the City Council establishing a schedule of fees to be charged by the Building and Safety, Planning, and Public Works Departments for various charges, was introduced and discussed at length.

Each Council member expressed concern at the necessity of raising fees. Vice Mayor DeMirjyn stated that he was opposed to any raise at this time.

City Manager Merritt explained that even with the recommended increases all the City's out-of-pocket costs were not entirely being recovered, and that there have been no increases in these fees for five years.

The Council discussed the over-all taxes in detail, and the advantage to the average taxpayer of having adequate fees charged for specialized procedures.

Councilman Sewall moved to approve Resolution No. 2912, with Mayor Cummings seconding. The motion failed with the following vote:

Councilman Knudsen then moved that the charge of \$200 for zone change be lowered to \$100 with the per acre cost raised to \$10.00 per acre. This motion lost for lack of a second.

Mr. Lawrence Ridge, manager of Lindsay Grove apartments, addressed Council with concern about rising water and sewer rates. This was briefly discussed and Council invited Mr. Ridge to meet with the Manager and the committee considering water rates.

Ordinance No. 1471, an ordinance of the City of Redlands amending the Redlands Ordinance Code and Adopting the 1971 Edition of the Uniform Fire Code, was given first reading of the title and laid over under the rules with public hearing thereon set for January 4, 1972 at 7:00 P.M., with notice given that three copies of this new code are available in the office of the City Clerk for review or study by those interested.

City Manager Merritt requested approval of expenditure of \$900 from Industrial Development funds for engineering fees for design of relocation of the Airport Access. Following discussion, approval was given, on motion of Councilman Knudsen, seconded by Councilman Sewall, by the following roll call vote:
