Council approved the submittal of applications for two projects under the Public Works Employment Act by the following motion made by Councilman Knudsen:

Public Works Employment Act "I move approval for the filing of applications under the Public Works Employment Act, including assurances and certification that the City as applicant shall comply with the regulations, policies, guidelines, and requirements, including Office of Management and Budget Circular A-96 and Federal Management Circular 74-4 and 74-7, as they relate to the application, acceptance, and use of Federal funds for this federally assisted project, and that Mr. W. C. Schindler, Community Development Director, is identified as the official representative of the City, for the following projects:

- "l. Surfacing of Redlands Boulevard from Alabama to Ford Streets.
- "2. Improvement of City Maintenance Yard."
