<u>Downtown Analysis</u> - A joint meeting with the Redevelopment Agency of the City of Redlands was held at this time to hear a presentation by Al Aguiar, Managing Principal of Marketing for Professionals regarding their recent Retail Market Opportunity Analysis: Downtown.

The City Council recessed at 9:40 A.M. and reconvened at 9:50 A.M.

<u>Utility Users Tax</u> - It was recommended that the discussion about the proposed ordinance for the Utilities Users Tax which is scheduled for the June 1990 election be continued to February 27, 1990, at 9:00 A.M. in order to allow additional time for return and compilation of the survey. Councilmember concurred with this recommendation.

<u>Solid Waste</u> - On behalf of the Solid Waste Task Force, Claude Johnson presented their recommendation regarding the mandatory once per week waste collection and optional once per week rate offering. The Task Force recommended that the City Council not approve the staff plan for implementing a mandatory once per week waste collection program at this time as they felt the plan is premature. Councilmember discussed this with members of the Task Force with Mayor DeMirjyn and Councilmember Cunningham indicating their desire to implement the once per week waste collection.

The meeting recessed at 10:50 A.M. to a closed session for the purpose of discussing personnel matters.
