Senior Center

Community Services Director Rodriguez reviewed information gathered since the March 5, 1991, Council meeting regarding funding for the multipurpose senior center. Information was provided from the Chief Building Official and the Fire Marshall following an inspection of the the City-owned structure at 114 Vine Street. The architecutral drawings for the addition to this structure done several years ago for Family Services have not yet been located. Council expressed concerns about transferring funds budgeted for other projects without communicating with the parties involved first. Mr. Rodriguez also reported the director of the YMCA has approached him to expand their facility for use by the senior program.

Mr. A. Louis Oder urged Council to make a decision. Mr. Tony Martinez presented copies of a petition demanding the facility be built on San Bernardino Avenue.

Council requested additional information regarding the YMCA proposal and that the search for the 114 Vine Street plans be continued.
