This special meeting of the Council was called for the purpose of considering a resolution requesting the State Highway Commission to provide for the construction of an off ramp which would permit southbound traffic on State Route No. 106 to exit the freeway onto the frontage road to be constructed north of Interstate 10 between Alabama Street and Tennessee Street, and an on ramp from the frontage road to be constructed on the south side of Interstate 10 between Alabama Street and Tennessee Street onto the northbound lane of State Route No. 106.

Following a presentation by Mr. Don Turpin in behalf of the businesses within the area of Freeway #10 and Alabama Street, and comments by Mr. John Runkel and Mr. Louis Fletcher, the Council discussed the matter at length. They questioned the above gentlemen and Director of Public Works John Shone.

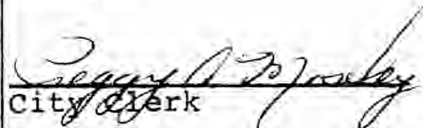
Councilman Miller then moved that Council adopt Resolution 2814, which

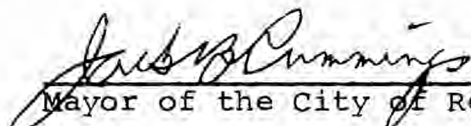
is a resolution of the City Council Requesting Ramp Changes for State Route No. 106. The motion was seconded by Councilman Knudsen and passed unanimously.
