An Ordinance of the City of Redlands, Determining That Certain

Lands Described Herein Are Necessary and Proper To BE Acquired and Held by

Said City for the Uses and Purposes of a Public Park.

The Board of Trustees of the City of Redlands, do resolve and ordain as follows:-

Section 1.- The Board of Trustees of said city dees hereby determine and declare that the public interests and necessities of said city and of the inhabitants thereoff demand the acquisition of the lands hereinafter described as a municipal improvement for the usegand purposes of a public park in said city and it does hereby determine and declare that said lands are necessary, proper and convenient to be acquired and held for the uses and purposes of said public park, and to carry out the objects, purpose, and powers of said city and that it is the intention of said city to so acquire and hold said lands, to wit:-

All that certain property situated in the City of Redlands, San Bernardino County, California, described as follows, to wit:Lots Number 6, 7, 8, 9, 23, 24, and 25 of Block "E" of the Orange Grove Addition to the Town of Redlands according to a map thereof of record in the office of the County Recorder of the said County, in Book 4, of maps, page 38.

Section 2.- That the object and purpose of acquiring said lands is to furnish the same to said city and the inhabitants thereof for the uses and purposes of a public park, and that the acquisition of such lands for the uses and purposes aforesaid is necessary and convenient to carry out the objects, purposes and powers of said city; and that the cost thereof will be too great to be paid out of the ordinary annual income and revenue of said city and it is necessary to incur an indebtedness therefor in excess of the money in the treasury of said city applicable thereto, and in excess of any money which will come into said treasury

Section 3.- This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
