

An Ordinance prescribing additional licenses, and providing for their collection.

The Board of Trustees of the City of Ordinance do ordain as follows:

Sec. 1. For the purpose of regulation and revenue the kinds of business hereinafter specified in addition to those provided for by Ordinance No. 20, shall be licensed in the city of Redlands, as follows:
1. Selling ^{other than fruit, vegetables, fish and ice} merchandise at retail by any dealer engaged in the business of selling the same, or by the agent of any such dealer, when such dealer or such agent has no permanent place of business in said city; at that rate of two dollars per day.

2. Soliciting or canvassing for any periodical, ant published, or any publication, issued or published in installments; ~~by any person having no permanent place of business in~~ at the rate of two dollars per day.

Sec. 2. No person, company, or corporation, shall engage, in said city, in either of the aforesaid kinds of business without having first having paid the amount of the license therefor by the foregoing section.

Sec. 3. The provisions of Sections 3, 6, 7 and 8, of Ordinance No. 20, passed March

5, 1889, shall apply in carrying out
the provisions of this ordinance, and
the penalties ~~in~~ ^{for} any violation of
such provisions.

Sec. 4, this ordinance shall take
effect from and after the date
of its passage.
