

An ordinance for the protection of plants and flowers from
trespassers.

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~~ORDINANCE NO. 298~~

The Board of Trustees of the City of Redlands, do ordain as follows:

Sec 1. Any person who, within the corporate limits of the city of Redlands, and without permission of the owner, shall dig up, pull up, cut, break, mutilate or in any way wilfully destroy or injure any ornamental or flowering tree, shrub, vine or plant, planted and growing upon the land of another, or shall cut, pick, break off, gather or take any flower or bud^{or seed} or fruit being or growing upon any such tree, shrub, vine or plant, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and punishable by fine not exceeding one hundred dollars or by imprisonment in the city jail not exceeding ten days days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Sec. 2. For the purposes of the foregoing section, the owner of land abutting upon any public street, alley, ^{or} road, shall be deemed the owner of said street, alley or road, to the middle line thereof opposite his land.

Sec. 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, and publication as required by law.
