

Ordinance No. 290.

An ordinance amending Ordinance No. 281 of the City of Redlands, entitled "An Ordinance to revise and codify the Ordinances of the City of Redlands" by adding two sections to Chapter 5, Article 3, to be known as sections 246 and 247.

The Board of Trustees of the City of Redlands do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Ordinance No. 281 of the City of Redlands, passed on the 18th day of September 1901, the title to which is recited in the title hereof, is hereby amended by adding to Chapter 5 Article 3 of said Ordinance, two new sections to be known as sections 246 and 247, and to read as follows:

Section 246. The establishment or maintenance within the limits of the City of Redlands of a sanatorium, hospital or place for the reception or treatment of tuberculosis or *except by Municipal authority for quarantine purposes* other contagious or infectious disease is hereby declared to be a misdemeanor.

Section 247. Every violation of the provisions of the preceding section shall be punishable by a fine of not exceeding \$ 300.00 or by imprisonment in the County jail for a term not exceeding *three months,*

or by both such fine and imprisonment

Section 2. This ordinance is numbered 290 and shall take effect from and after the date of its passage.
