

ORDINANCE NO. 1119

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE ANNEXATION OF CERTAIN UNINHABITED TERRITORY, DESIGNATED "ANNEXATION NO. 9", TO THE CITY OF REDLANDS, CALIFORNIA.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF REDLANDS:

WHEREAS, on the 21st day of June, 1960, the Council of the City of Redlands did pass and adopt Resolution No. 2044 giving notice of the proposal to annex certain uninhabited territory to the City of Redlands, said territory being therein designated as "Annexation No. 9", said Resolution describing the boundaries of the territory proposed to be annexed; and

WHEREAS, said Resolution No. 2044 did contain a notice of the day, hour and place when and where the Council of the City would hear protests made by any person owning property within the territory proposed to be annexed, the time of said hearing being not less than fifteen nor more than fifty days from the date of passage of said Resolution; and

WHEREAS, on the 19th day of July, 1960 at the hour of 7:00 P.M. in the Council Chambers in the City Hall of the City of Redlands, County of San Bernardino, State of California, said time and place being the day, hour and place fixed in said Resolution No. 2044 for hearing protests to the said annexation, and as continued to August 1, 1960, at the same time and place, the said City Council did hear and pass upon all protests made to the proposed annexation and did determine that protests had not been made by the owners of one-half of the value of the territory proposed to be annexed as shown by the last equalized assessment roll, nor by public and private owners of one-half of the value of the territory proposed to be annexed as determined by said legislative body; and

WHEREAS, said territory is contiguous to the City of Redlands, and is uninhabited territory in the County of San Bernardino;

NOW, THEREFORE, the said City Council of the City of Redlands does hereby approve the annexation of the territory hereinafter described to the City of Redlands, and does hereby further ordain that the said territory be and is hereby annexed to the City of Redlands.

That said territory, the annexation of which to the City of Redlands is herein approved, is all that territory situated in the County of San Bernardino, State of California, more particularly described as follows:

That portion of the East half of the Southwest quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) Northeast quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Fifteen (15), Township one (1) South, Range Three (3) West, San Bernardino Base and Meridian, County of San Bernardino, State of California, according to Government Survey, described as follows: Beginning at a point on the East line of said East half of the East half of the Southwest quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Northeast quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Fifteen (15), which is Thirteen (13) feet northerly from the Southeast corner thereof; thence along said East line, Northerly 695.8 feet; thence parallel with the South line of said Southwest quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Northeast quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Fifteen (15),

Westerly Three Hundred Thirty (330) feet more or less to a point on the West line of said East half of the East half of the Southwest quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Northeast quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Fifteen (15); thence along said line Southerly 593.8 feet to a point which is One Hundred Fifteen (115) feet Northerly from the Southwest corner of the East half of the East half of the Southwest quarter (SW $\frac{1}{4}$) of the Northeast quarter (NE $\frac{1}{4}$) of Section Fifteen (15); thence on a direct line, Southeasterly 346.46 feet more or less to the point of beginning.
