Section 1.—That the annexation to the City of Redlands of the territory hereinafter described by the electors in such territory by their vote at an election held therein on March 15th, 1923, be and the same is hereby approved, and such territory is hereby annexed to such city.

The territory so annexed to said city is situated in San Bernardino County, State of California, bounded and described as follows, to-wit:

'Commencing at a point on the west line of the City of Redlands, three hundred ninety-five (395) feet northerly of the north line of Olive Avenue and three hundred and intety-five (395) feet therefrom westerly to a point on the west line of Section thirty-three (33). Township One (1) South, Range Three (3) West, S. B. B. M.; thence along the west line of said Section 33, and Section 4, Township 2 South, Range 3 West, S. B. B. M., to a point five hundred (500) feet southerly from the south line of the Southerly from the south line of said Southern Pacific Company's railroad right of way and five hundred (600) feet therefrom easterly to the west city line; thence northerly along the west city line; thence northerly along the west city and five hundred (500) feet there-from easterly to the west city line:
