

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDLANDS

relating to persons under the age of 18 years visiting, entering, being or remaining in any Billiard Halls or Pool Rooms.

The Board of Trustees of the City of Redlands do ordain as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person under the age of eighteen years of age to visit, enter, be or remain in any Billiard Hall or Pool Room in the City of Redlands.

Section 2. It shall be unlawful for the proprietor, manager, or person in charge of any Billiard Hall or Pool Room in the City of Redlands to allow or permit any person under the age of eighteen years of age to visit, enter, be or remain in such place in his care, charge, ownership or management.

Section 3. Any person violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine not exceeding \$100. or by imprisonment in the County jail of San Bernardino County for a term not exceeding one month, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage.
