

ORDINANCE NO. 1042

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDLANDS AMENDING
A SECTION OF THE REDLANDS ORDINANCE CODE
REGARDING MINORS IN BILLIARD HALLS AND POOLROOMS

The City Council of the City of Redlands Ordains as
Follows:

SECTION ONE: Section 5304 of Chapter 53 of the
Redlands Ordinance Code is hereby amended to read
as follows:

5304: MINORS IN BILLIARD HALLS, POOLROOMS

To permit or allow any minor under the age of
eighteen (18) years to visit, enter, or be
present at any billiard hall or poolroom.

SECTION TWO: This ordinance shall take effect in 30
days and prior to fifteen days from the passage
thereof shall be published once in the Redlands
Daily Facts, a newspaper of general circulation
printed and published in the City of Redlands,
California.
