

Ordinance No 44

An Ordinance supplementing to Ordinance No. 37 relating to the Board of Health, and repealing part of said Ordinance.

The Board of Trustees of the City of Colorado do hereby enact as follows:—

Sec. 1. Every physician shall immediately report to the Secretary of the Board of Health of the City, every patient such physician shall have therein labored in any form of epidemic, or sporadic or infectious disease; and he shall also report to such officer the death of any person in the City, attended by him in any of said last sickness, immediately after such death shall have occurred.

Sec. 2. The head of every household in the City shall report to said Secretary every death occurring in such household immediately.

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Dec. 3. Every physician, and every midwife assisting at the birth of a child shall, within one week after such birth, report the name of the child, the date of the birth, the date thereof, the name, birth place, sex, and color of the child, whether living, or still-born, the name and place of birth of the parents, and the maiden name of the mother. In the case of a birth unattended by any physician or midwife, the report herein required shall be made by the head of the household in which such death occurred.

Dec. 4. The reports of deaths and births required by this ordinance shall be made up on cards to be furnished by the said Rectory, or by the Clerk of the City, in

Application therefor. And
the reports of ^{deaths} shall
give the name of the de-
ceased, the date of death,
residence, former residence,
name of father, name of
mother, birth place of parents
and their nationality.

Sec. 5. The reports furnished un-
der this Ordinance shall
be filed by the said Re-
turning with the clerk of
the City who shall re-
cord the same in appropria-
te books.

Sec. 6
A violation of any provision
of Section 1, 2, 3 or 4 of
this Ordinance shall be
a misdemeanor, and shall
be punished by a fine of
not more than fifty dol-
lars nor less than five dol-
lars, or by imprisonment
in the county jail or city
prison for ^{not} more
than ^{days} ~~months~~ nor less than
two days, or by both and
fine and imprisonment.

Sec. 7. Section 4 of Ordinance

No. 37 is hereby repealed,
Sec. 8, this Ordinance shall
take effect from and
after the date of its
passage
