

An Ordinance fixing the
bonds, and compensation of
certain officers.

The Board of Trustees of the
City of Redlands do ordain as
follows:

Section 1, The Clerk, Treasurer and
Marshal of said City of Redlands
hereafter elected, shall, respec-
tively, before entering upon the
duties of their respective offices
each execute to said City a bond
conditioned for the faithful per-
formance of ~~the~~ duties, ~~of this office~~
and in the following penal sum
to wit:

The Clerk, in the penal sum
of one thousand dollars;
The Treasurer, in the penal
sum of ten thousand dollars;
The Marshals in the penal
sum of ~~ten~~ ^{eight} thousand dollars,

Section 2, Beginning with the next term
of office of the above named offi-
cers, their compensation respectively
shall be and hereby is fixed as
follows, ~~to wit: that the compensation of~~
the Clerk shall be ^{seventy-five} ~~seventy~~ dollars per
month, ~~payable~~ ^{monthly}.

The compensation of the Treasurer shall be a sum equal to one per cent on all moneys received and paid by him for such business, and he may credit himself with such per cent in his settlements with the Clerk. The compensation of the Marshal shall be ^{Twenty} ~~Twenty~~ dollars per month, to be paid in arrears, and in addition to his duties as Marshal, and Tax and License collector, he shall act as Poundmaster, Street Inspector and Health Officer; and the aforesaid compensation shall be in lieu of any and all fees allowed him by law, which fees he shall receive and pay over to ~~the~~ said city.

Section 3. The Recorder of the city shall receive as compensation fees as follows, to wit: for all prosecutions for violations of any ordinance of said city, such fees as are or may be allowed by law to a Justice of the Peace for like services in criminal prosecutions for misdemeanors; and in all other cases the fees charged and collected by him which fees shall be the same as are or may be allowed by law to Justices of

the Peace for like services. And
the Recorder may credit himself
with much fees in his settlements
with the Clerk

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take
effect from and after the
date of ~~its~~ passage.
