

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDLANDS

Adding a new Section to the Building Regulations of said City.

The Board of Trustees of the City of Redlands do ordain as follows:

Section 1. A new section is hereby added to Article XV of Ordinance No. 430 ~~to be~~ of said city to be numbered 142 1/2, and to read as follows:

"Section 142 1/2. Pipes. All pipes, <sup>exceeding in length six feet</sup> ~~which~~ for conveyance of water for either household or domestic use shall not be less in size than that commonly known as three-quarter inch pipe. All screw pipe used in or about any building or elsewhere must be reamed and where cut or jointed, and

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force upon its passage.
