

ORDINANCE NO. 376

An Ordinance of the City of Redlands, prohibiting open closets within certain limits.

The Board of Trustees of the City of Redlands do ordain as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for the owner or occupant of any lot, piece of parcel of land abutting upon any street or avenue in said city in which there ^{now or may hereafter be} is a sewer system or pipe for the conducting of sewerage, to maintain, or allow, or permit to exist upon such lot, piece of parcel of land, any water closet, urinal or sink or place designated or used as a receptacle ~~for~~ refuse matter, offal or human excrement, except the same be connected with such sewer system or pipe for the conducting of sewerage in accordance with the provisions of Chapter VIII of Ordinance No. 281 of the City of Redlands.

Section 2. Any place, water closet, urinal or sink maintained or used in violation of section 1 of this ordinance is hereby ~~and~~ declared to be a public nuisance.

Section 3. Any person guilty of maintaining a public nuisance in violation of this ordinance, and any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punishable by a fine not exceeding \$50 or by imprisonment in the City jail not exceeding 25 days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.
