

Ordinance No 225.

An ordinance regulating the burning of brush within the city limits.

The Board of Trustees of the City of Redlands do ordain as follows:

Section 1, As a police measure deemed necessary for the better protection of property and for the better preservation of quiet and good order in said city, it is hereby made unlawful to start or to maintain, ~~any brush fire~~ upon any lot or parcel of land within the city of Redlands, any brush fire ~~that~~ ^{over} one hundred and fifty feet of any building or to start or maintain, ^{or suffer to continue} any such fire between the hours of 8 o'clock P.M. of any day and the hour of five o'clock A.M. of the preceding day.

Section 2, Any and every violation of this ordinance is hereby declared to be a misdemeanor and shall be punishable by a fine of not less than eight dollars nor more than one hundred dollars or by imprisonment in the City Prison for not less than one day nor

more than ten days.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage.
