AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDLANDS, CALIFORNIA, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 867 ENTITLED "AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDLANDS, CALIFORNIA, LICENSING FOR THE PURPOSE OF REVENUE, ALL AND EVERY KIND OF BUSINESS CARRIED ON IN SAID CITY: FIXING THE RATE OF LICENSE THEREFOR AND PROVIDING FOR THE COLLECTION THEREOF, PRESCRIBING THE PENALTY FOR VIOLATIONS OF ITS PROVISIONS AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH," ADOPTED MAY 31ST, 1946.

The City Council of the City of Redlands does ordain as follows:

Section One: That Ordinance No. 895, adopted May 31st, 1946, and entitled as above set forth, is hereby amended by adding a new Section thereto to be entitled Section 61A and to read as follows:

Section 61A. For every person, firm or corporation, who shall conduct, manage or carry on the business of police patrol, police protection or merchant patrol, the license for such business shall be \$300.00 per annum. Further that no license shall be issued until a permit to carry on such business has been first obtained from the City Council, which permit shall be subject to such rules and regulations as the said Council shall deem necessary.

Section Two: This ordinance shall become effective as provided for by law.

Section Three: The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this ordinance and shall cause the same to be published once in the Redlands Daily Facts, a daily newspaper hereby designated for that purpose.
