

ORDINANCE--NO. 296.

An Ordinance prohibiting the carrying on of the business of a barber shop during certain hours of each week.

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The Board of trustees of the City of Redlands do ordain as follows:

Sec.1:- No person shall, within the City of Redlands, during the hours between midnight of Saturday and ~~six o'clock~~ ^{Midnight} ~~A.M.~~ of the following ~~Sunday~~ ^{Sunday}, of any week, either as proprietor, manager, lessee, employee, or agent, open, conduct or carry on the business of a barber shop or hair dressing establishment, or perform, at any place of business, between said hours, any work as a barber or hair dresser; provided that any barber shop or hair dressing establishment in which baths are maintained or furnished for customers may be kept open, and the business thereof carried on, between said hours, solely for such bathing purposes.

Sec.2:- The doors and windows of all barber shops and hair dressing establishments, and all places where the business or work of a barber or hair dresser is carried on, shall, during all the time between said hours, be so arranged and so kept free from obstruction, by curtains or otherwise, as to permit a full and unobstructed view from the street of the interior of such shops, establishments and places of business.

Sec.3:- Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and be punishable by a fine of not less than Five dollars, nor more than \$100.00 dollars, or by imprisonment in the City jail not to exceed 30 days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.
