

ORDINANCE No. 439

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDLANDS

Amending Section 72, 44, 48 of Ordinance 430, and adding a new section to Ordinance No. 433, and amending Section 13 thereof.

The Board of Trustees of the City of Redlands do ordain as follows:

Section 1. A ~~new~~ subdivision is hereby added to Section 72 of Ordinance No. 430 of the City of Redlands and to read as follows:

44-1/2. Any person engaged in any line of business in said City not hereinbefore enumerated and not otherwise fixed by ordinance shall pay a license fee of Two Dollars per quarter.

SECTION 2. A new section is hereby added to Ordinance No. 433 of said City to be known as Section 15 thereof to read as follows:-

SECTION 15. For the purpose of this ordinance, the word "Public place" is defined to mean any place generally or commonly known or called or regarded as a public place or any store room or place of business or any portion of any lot upon which such store room or place of business is located in said city or any street, avenue, alley way or public park or in any unenclosed barn, shed or stall.

SECTION 3. Section 13 of ordinance No. 433 of said City is hereby amended to read as follows:

Any person violating any of the provisions of Section 7 of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined not exceeding \$300. or by imprisonment in the County jail of San Bernardino County not exceeding ninety days or by both such fine and imprisonment and any person violating any of the other provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined not less than \$100. ~~and~~ by imprisonment in the said County jail not less than thirty days, nor more than \$300. and ninety days in said County jail.

SECTION 4. Subdivision 6 of Section 48 of ordinance No. 430 of said City is hereby amended to read as follows:-

6. Engaging in Gambling Games.- To play, engage in, or bet upon any gambling game, not mentioned in Section 330 of the Penal Code of the State of California, or to play or operate any machine, contrivance or device upon which money is staked or hazarded upon chance, or upon the result of the action of which money is staked, bet, won or lost upon chance, or to gamble in any manner whatever different from the provisions of said Section 330. Any such machine, contrivance or device so used or operated is hereby declared to be a public nuisance.

~~SECTION 6. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.~~

Section 5. Section 125 of Ordinance 430 as amended by Ordinance No. 437 is hereby amended by striking out of said Section the following words "in buildings the wiring of which has already been inspected."

Section 6. This ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage.

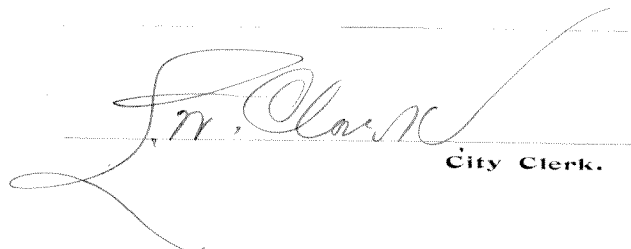
