

ORDINANCE NO. 1071

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDLANDS REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 977.

Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Redlands that:

SECTION ONE: Ordinance No. 977 enacted the 16th day of August, 1954, entitled "AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDLANDS REQUIRING THAT ALL CITY TAXES BE PAID, OR A SURETY BOND FURNISHED FOR THE PAYMENT THEREOF, BEFORE ANY SUB-DIVISION, LOT SPLIT, OR DIVISION OF LAND INTO TWO OR MORE PARCELS IS APPROVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL; AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 884," be and the same is hereby repealed.

SECTION TWO: This ordinance shall take effect in 30 days and prior to fifteen days from the passage hereof shall be published once in the Redlands Daily Facts, a newspaper of general circulation, printed and published in the City of Redlands, California.
