

An ordinance concerning the cleaning and sprinkling of streets and alleys of Redlands. The Board of Directors of the City of Redlands do ordain as follows: Section 1. The following streets and portions of streets in said city; to wit:

except the front portions thereof and one block away therefrom,

within the limits named, shall, to the extent of keeping the same free from dust, be kept sprinkled with oil used for such purposes.

Section 2. All said sprinkling with oil of said streets shall be done under the supervision and direction of the Superintendent of Streets of said City, and said City shall cause all said oiling of said streets to be done at the lowest possible cost, and the expense thereof shall be borne as follows: to wit:

One half of all the cost and expense of so oiling each of said streets shall be paid by said City and the owners, occupants and agents of the owner of lands fronting on said streets. When so oiled shall pay one half of all the cost and expense of such oiling apportioned to the property so owned, occupied or controlled by them respectively, to the center of the street; provided however that any person or persons liable for any such oiling hereunder

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may prevent ^{all} said city at any time his or their officers
in writing to ^{all} the said ailing on any said streets of
for all his or their property or the center of the street after
it lying in said of the space or space included therein
and the whole cost and expense of such ailing charged to them
and the term
and if said city be with them willing to do all such
ailing at a lower rate than is specified in any such bond
if any such person or persons may do all such ailing
as specified during such term at the cost and profit and
recover one half of such cost thereof from said city; and
provided further that in case of failure to do any such
ailing by any person or persons after making any such of
said city shall do such ailing and the person or persons
so failing shall be liable for the whole cost thereof and
shall not have the right to ^{make} any such of fee again within
one year of date of failure.

Section 3. The cost and expense of all such ailing
of said streets that shall become due to said city as
herein provided shall be recoverable by suit or
otherwise and in addition any failure or
refusal to pay the same of his due demands therefor
shall be a misdemeanor and is punishable
by a fine of not less than three dollars, nor more
than fifty dollars.

scribed territory, between East and West Highland Avenue on
the south, and East and West Colton Avenue on the north, and
between Church and Reservoir streets on the East, and San Mateo
street to Brookside Avenue, thence northerly on the line of
Second street produced northerly to West Colton Avenue, *on the*
West;

Sec. 4. All persons owning property in the City of Redlands fronting upon any public street, lane or alley of said City, are hereby required to keep the gutter and sidewalk in front of said property and the space between the curb line and the property line of said property free from weeds and all vegetation growing thereon, except such as may be lawfully sown or planted for ornamental purposes.

Sec. 5. Whenever it shall appear that the provisions of Sec. 4, are being violated, it shall be the duty of the Superintendent of Streets to notify the owner or occupant of such premises of the violation, and upon the failure of such owner or occupant to thereupon remove such weeds or vegetation within ~~twenty four~~ *ten days* ~~hours~~, it shall be the duty of the Superintendent of Streets to remove the same at the expense of such owner or occupant, *and such expense shall be recoverable by and of the city and its authorities.*

Sec. 6. A failure to remove such weeds or vegetation upon notice as provided in Sec. 5 shall be deemed a misdemeanor, and shall be punishable by a fine of not ~~exceeding~~ *less than* ~~thirty~~ *more than* ~~dollars,~~ *fifty dollars.* or by imprisonment in the City Jail for a term not exceeding ~~days,~~ or by both such fine and imprisonment.

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~~Proposed new Ordinance on Sidewalks.~~

Sec. 7. All persons owning property in the City of Redlands fronting upon any public street, lane or alley of said City, are hereby required to keep the gutter and sidewalk in front of said property and the space between the curb line and the property line of said property free from dirt, filth, garbage, ~~or~~ rubbish, other than the natural soil of the same, and to keep ^{between the curb line and property line} said sidewalk and space in good and sufficient repair, and free from obstructions dangerous to life or limb.

Sec. A violation of the foregoing section shall constitute a misdemeanor, and any person violating the same or any part thereof shall, upon conviction, be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and shall be punishable by a fine not exceeding dollars or by imprisonment in the City Jail for a period not exceeding days or by both such fine and imprisonment.

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Sec. 8. ^{on the surface} It is hereby made unlawful to throw, or deposit in any yard, street, alley, sidewalk, gutter or public ditch or vacant or occupied lot within the City limits, any posters, wrapping paper, waste paper, hand bills, old clothes, boots, shoes, hats, tin cans, baling wire, broken dishes, or any rubbish whatsoever.

Any persons violating the provisions of this Section shall, upon conviction thereof, be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor.

Section 9. Any violation of the provisions of this ordinance is punishable by a fine of not less than three dollars nor more than fifty dollars.

Section 10. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
