

ORDINANCE No. 351

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDLANDS

relating to the construction and laying of gutters, curbs and sidewalks therein.

The Board of Trustees of the City of Redlands do ordain as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to lay or construct any gutter, curb or sidewalk upon any of the public streets of the City of Redlands, without first obtaining from the Board of Trustees of said city, permission so to do, and from the City Engineer, the lines and grades upon and along which the same is to be laid, or to lay or construct any gutter, curb or sidewalk upon any such streets upon lines or grades other than those furnished to him by such City Engineer.

Section 2. It shall be unlawful for any person to lay or construct any gutter, curb or sidewalk upon any of such public streets, without first notifying the street superintendent of said city of the time and place, when and where, such work will be begun.

Section 3. It shall be unlawful for any person to lay or construct any cement sidewalk upon or along any of the public streets in said city unless the same shall be constructed in accordance with Specifications No. 3 1/2, for cement sidewalks, adopted by the Board of Trustees of said City on the 25 day of May 1904, and on file in the office of the City Clerk thereof.

Section 4. It shall be the duty of the City Engineer of said City to furnish to any person, upon request, the lines and grades for any work proposed to be done by such person whenever the Board of Trustees of said City shall have granted permission to do such work, and the material for such work shall have been delivered upon the ground therefor; and it shall be the duty of the Street Superintendent to inspect any such work, from time to time, during the progress thereof, and to remove or cause to be removed from such street or streets any of such work done thereon after the passage of this ordinance, that does not comply with the lines and grades that shall have been given or furnished by the City Engineer for such work, or with the specifications for such work that have been adopted therefor by said Board of Trustees.

Section 5. Every person who shall violate any of the provisions of this ordinance, except Section 4 thereof, shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof, shall be punishable by a fine not exceeding \$100.00, or by imprisonment not exceeding 25 days, in the County Jail of San Bernardino County, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 6. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.
