

Ordinance No. 1064,

An Ordinance providing for
imposing and collecting high
upward license upon dogs
owned or harbored in the
City of Reklamah.

The Board of Trustees of the
City of Reklamah do ordain as
follows:-

Section 1. There shall be and hereby be
imposed an annual license of
five dollars upon every male
dog, and of four dollars upon
every female dog hereafter owned
or harbored within the limits
of the City of Reklamah.

Section 2. On or before the first day
of March in each year every
person owning or harboring a dog
within said city, shall cause said
dog to be registered by some
person or persons with the
Clerk of said City, and said Clerk
shall then prepare a license for
such dog the amount of which
license shall be fixed in conform-
ity with Section one hereof, and
he has the same to the Treasurer
of the City who shall forthwith
collect such amount, and the per-
son owning or harboring said dog
shall pay said amount on demand
made by said Treasurer.

The marshal shall
payment thereof deliver said
license and the plate hereinafter
mentioned to ~~the~~ ^{such} person ~~and~~
~~ing as herein provided~~
who shall cause such plate to be at-
tached to a collar, and cause
such collar to be placed and
kept round the neck of said
dog.

Sec'n 3. The Clerk of this city shall cause
to be ~~presented~~ ^(presented) before the first
day of March in each year a
sufficient number of metallic
plates for use, as provided
in Section two hereof, in each
year convenient place,
and having stamped thereon
the letters C. D. L., one of
which plates shall be de-
livered to the marshal with
each license placed in ^{his} hands
for collection as aforesaid. The
shape and size of said plates
shall be changed each year.

Section 3 - A failure to comply with a
my of the provisions of this Ordinance
by any person responsible for owning
or harboring a dog in said city
shall be and is hereby declared to
be a misdemeanor and shall be
punishable by a fine of not less
than five dollars nor more than
twenty dollars or by imprisonment
in the City Prison for not
less than one day nor more

Section 4. The provision of Section 6 and
my of Ordinance No. 20 entitled "An
Ordinance prescribing certain diseases
and providing for the collection thereof
of money March 3, 1889, shall apply
to this Ordinance as to the duties of
the Officer mentioned in said Section
6, and as to suit for to collect a
