

ORDINANCE NO. 264,

An Ordinance imposing a license upon dogs, and for providing for the collection thereof, and the disposing of dogs not licensed.

The Board of Trustees of the City of Redlands do ordain as follows:

Section 1. There is hereby imposed an annual license of ~~One Dollar~~ ^{two dollars} and one-half upon every male dog and of ~~Three~~ ^{four} Dollars upon every female dog owned or harbored within the limits of said City of Redlands, which license shall be due and payable from the person owning or harboring such dog, to the Marshal of said City on and after the second Monday in June of each year.

Section 2. On or before the second Monday in June of each year the Clerk of the City shall procure a sufficient number of blank license receipts for ~~One Dollar and One-half~~ ^{two dollars} and also for ~~Three~~ ^{four} Dollars, for that year, and shall number, sign and deliver the same to the Marshal, taking his receipt therefor and charging him therewith.

Section 3. The Marshal shall on the second Monday in June of each year proceed to collect the license imposed by Section 1 of this Ordinance from the persons owning or harboring dogs, and upon payment of the license he shall issue to the person paying one of the receipts, provided for by Section 2 of this Ordinance, for ~~One and One-half~~ ^{two} Dollars or for ~~Three~~ ^{four} Dollars as the case may require, and also one of the plates hereinafter mentioned, and the Marshal shall continue such collection until all licenses due under this Ordinance shall be collected.

Section 4. The Clerk of the City shall procure, before the first Monday in June of each year, a sufficient number of metallic

1 shape and size of such plates shall be different each year.

2 Section 5. The license imposed by this Ordinance shall
3 apply only to all dogs of the age of six months and over, and
4 said license shall be due and payable from every person owning or
5 harboring any dog of, or over, said age, within said City, at any
6 time during any such license year.

7 Any and every dog owned or harbored in said City for ten
8 days without the payment of said license, and without being tagged
9 as in this Ordinance provided, shall thereafter be deemed, and is
10 hereby declared to be a public nuisance until such license be paid
11 and any such dog be so tagged, and the Marshal of said City is
12 authorized to summarily abate any such public nuisance by ^{killing} ~~destroy-~~
13 ~~ing the same~~ dog.

14 It is hereby made the duty of every person owning or har-
15 boring any such dog or dogs within said City to pay at once said
16 license to said Marshal, and to tag as herein required any such
17 dog or dogs.

18 Section 6. A failure to pay the license imposed by this
19 Ordinance is hereby made punishable by a fine of not less than
20 Six Dollars and not more than Twenty Dollars.

21 Section 7. ^{Ordinance No 179 and} All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances in con-
22 flict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

23 Section 8. This Ordinance shall take effect from and after
24 its passage, and the Clerk of said Board shall certify the pas-
25 sage hereof and publish the same by at least one insertion in
26 the Redlands Daily Facts.
