ORDINANCE NO. 999

An EMERGENCY WATER REGULATION AND ORDINANCE.

Whereas there is now existing a critical water shortage within the City of Redlands endangering the health and welfare of its residences and residents and creating a serious fire hazard,

NOW THEREFORE, The City Council of the City of Redlands does ordain and order that there shall not be any domestic irrigation from the City Water System for lawns, ornamental trees, shrubbery, flowers or other foillage or domestic gardens at any time except between the hours of 7 O'clock P.M. and 9 O'Clock P.M. effective immediately and until further order of this City Council, and

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED AND DECLARED that this regulation and Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency order and ordinance for the immediate preservation of the public welfare, health and safety of the residents of this City and shall take effect immediately upon its passage and publication.

It is Further Ordered that any person, firm or corporation violating this regulation and ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not to exceed Twenty-Five Dollars or by imprisonment in the City or County Jail for a period of not exceeding five days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

The City Clerk shall certify to the adoption of this ordinance and cause it to be published once in the Redlands Daily Facts, a newspaper of general circulation printed and published in this City.
