edge or jurisdiction as the
State Board may require,
3^d. To a board, in writing,
the plans by which the drain-
age and plumbing of all
buildings hereafter erected
in the city, shall be executed.

The Health officers of the
city shall be the executive
officer of the Board of Health,
who shall see that the regu-
lations and requirements of
said Board are obeyed, He
shall also obtain and submit
to the Board the reports which

shall report to the Health

Officer in writing, every patient

in whom he has detected any

Every household in said city

shall immediately report in

writing, to the Health Officer

the name of every person board-

ing or inmate of such house.

The drainage and plumbing

of all buildings hereafter

erected in the city shall be

executed only in accordance

with laws previously approved

by the Board of Health.

2 criptions of such drainage and
3 plumbing shall in each case
4 be submitted to said Board,

Sec. 7 No person shall inter, cremate,
6 or otherwise dispose of any hu-
7 man body in the city with-
8 out first obtaining a per-
9 mit therefor from the Board
10 of Health. Such permit shall
11 be granted only on the applica-
12 tion by the person applying
13 therefor of a certificate sign-
14 ed by a physician, or a Cor-
15 oner, or two reputable citi-
16 zens, setting forth, as near as
17 possible, the name, age, place
18 of birth, occupation, date, fe-
19 cality, and cause of death of
20 deceased, which certificate
21 shall be filed with said Board,
22 and such permit shall be
23 filed with the County Record-
24 er of San Bernardino County, State
25 of California.

Sec 8 A violation of any of the
26 provisions of Sections 4, 5, 6,
27 and 7 of this Ordinance, shall
28

herely declared to be a mis-
demeanor, and shall be pun-
ished by a fine of not more
than two hundred dollars, nor
less than five dollars, or by
~~imprisonment in the County~~
jail or city prison for not
more than thirty days nor
less than ten days, or by
both such fine and im-
prisonment.

take effect from and af-
ter the date of its passage
