

Ordinance No 223

The ordinance amending Section 1 of Ordinance No. 7 as amended by ordinance No. 81, relating to the fire limits.

The Board of Trustees of the City of Redlands do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Section 1 of ordinance No. 7, passed January 8, 1889, entitled "an ordinance defining the fire limits, regulating the character of building, &c., as amended by ordinance No. 81, passed April 29, 1891, is hereby amended so ~~that~~ and Section shall read as follows; to wit:

Section 1. The fire limits of the City of Redlands shall be, and the same ~~are~~ hereby are established and defined as follows, to wit: Beginning at the intersection of the north line of the present right

of many of the Southern California
Railway Company with the center
line of ~~sixth~~ sheet in said city;
thence south along the center line of
said fifth sheet to its intersection
with the north line of Redwood
avenue; thence east along said north
line to the center line of sixth
sheet in said city; thence south
along the center line of said
sixth sheet to the center of
the alley between ^{east} Citrus avenue
and Vine street in said city; thence
west along the center line of said
~~said sheet~~ alley to a point
one fourth of the center line
of said fifth sheet; thence due
north to the center line of said
Vine street; thence west along
the center line of said Vine
street to the center line of
Fourth street in said city; thence

with along the center line of
said Fourth street to the center
line of ~~the~~ alley ^{west} between said
Vine street and Citrus avenue;
thence west along the center
line of said alley to the cen-
ter line of Eureka street in said
city; thence north-westerly along
the center line of said Eureka
street, and along said line
proposed to the center line of
Second street in said city; thence
north along the center line of
said Second street, and along
said line produced to the north
line of the present right of way
of the Southern California Rail-
way Company; thence east along
said north line of said right of way
to the place of beginning. And

no building, nor any addition to a
~~or~~ building, shall be erected or
built in such limits without a
permit from the President of the
Board of Trustees of said city,
provided that such permit shall
be issued on a satisfactory show-
ing that nothing in the proposed
structure will conflict with the
provisions of this ordinance.

Ord # 22

take effect from and after its
passage.
