

ORDINANCE NO. 819

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDLANDS REGULATING THE FIRING AND DISCHARGE OF GUNS IN THE CITY OF REDLANDS AND DECLARING GUNS IN THE POSSESSION OF MINORS UNDER THE AGE OF SIXTEEN YEARS TO BE NUISANCES AND PROVIDING FOR THE ABATEMENT THEREOF.

The City Council of the City of Redlands does ordain as follows:

Section One. Definitions: The term "gun" within the meaning of this Ordinance shall be construed to mean and include air guns, air rifles, pistols, revolvers and guns of any character fired by explosives. The singular number where used in this Ordinance shall include the plural, and the plural the singular.

Section Two. It shall be unlawful for any person to fire any gun within the corporate limits of the City of Redlands.

Section Three. Any gun in the possession of a minor under the age of sixteen years, in any place within the corporate limits of the City of Redlands, except within the home of any such minor, or except when such minor is in the direct charge and under the supervision of the parent or guardian of any such minor, is hereby declared to be a nuisance and to be subject to immediate seizure and confiscation when found in the possession of any minor under the age of sixteen years who is not so in charge and under the supervision of any such parent or guardian.

Section Four. This Ordinance shall not apply to any regularly established gun or rifle club or shooting gallery, the location of which has been previously approved in writing by the Chief of Police of the City of Redlands, nor to any person specially licensed by the City Council to destroy pests nor to officers in the discharge of their official duties.

Section Five. Any person violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and in addition to any other punishment herein prescribed, shall be liable to a fine of not to exceed \$50.00 or imprisonment in the City or County Jail for a period not to exceed thirty (30) days or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Section Six. This Ordinance shall be in force and effect after its passage and adoption in the manner provided by law. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this ordinance and cause the same to be published once in the Redlands Daily Facts.
