

ORDINANCE NO. 308.

An Ordinance to protect the streets of the city of Redlands from damage by overflow of flood water.

The Board of Trustees of the city of Redlands do ordain as follows:

Sec. 1.- It shall be unlawful for any person to construct or maintain, or cause to be constructed or maintained, any dam, gate or other ~~water~~ obstruction in or across any public wastewater or storm-water ditch or aqueduct in the city of Redlands; or to construct or maintain, or cause to be constructed or maintained, over or across any such ditch or aqueduct, any bridge or crossing or covering in such manner as to obstruct or impede the free passage of waste water or storm water along such ditch or aqueduct, to the extent of the full capacity thereof, *without permission first had and obtained from the Board of Trustees of said city.*

Sec. 2.- It shall be unlawful for any person to construct or maintain, or cause to be constructed or maintained in said city, any dam, gate or obstruction in or across the channel of any stream of water, whether natural or artificial, flowing in or through said city, and which stream shall, otherwise than through a pipe line, flow down to said city from the ^{mountains} ~~main~~tain or from any canyon beyond the limits of said city, provided that this section shall not apply to lateral irrigating ditches nor to the construction or maintenance of dams or gates for the diversion of water from any such stream into any lateral ditch for the purpose of irrigation, ^{and for power purposes,} provided that such dam or gate be so constructed and maintained that, when not in use for such diversion of water, the same shall be open in such manner as to offer no obstruction or impediment to the free passage of the water of such stream to the extent of the full capacity of the channel.

~~Sec. 4. This ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage.~~

Sec. 3. Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof, shall be punishable by a fine of not exceeding \$ 300.00 or imprisonment in the city jail for not exceeding 30 days, or by both said fine and imprisonment.

Sec. 4. This ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage.
