

ORDINANCE NO. 406.

An Ordinance of the City of Redlands Granting A Franchise for the Construction, Operation and Maintenance of a Street Railroad Upon Certain Streets Therein.

The Board of Trustees of the City of Redlands do ordain as follows:

Section 1. A franchise is hereby granted to C. C. Haskell and his assigns, to construct, operate and maintain a single track street railroad for the term of 50 years, over the route and upon and along the streets and portions of streets in said City described as follows:



Section 2. That the terms and conditions upon which said franchise is granted are as follows, to-wit:

Upon the same terms and conditions upon which said franchise was offered for sale in the Notice of Sale thereof as set forth in a resolution duly adopted by said Board of Trustees on the 18th day of October, 1906, for the sale of said franchise a copy of which resolution is recorded in full in the records of Ordinances of said City in Volume 4 thereof, from page 128 to and including page 132 of said Book of Ordinances, and reference is hereby made to such Ordinance Book and to said record thereof for further particulars as to such terms and conditions, and the same is hereby made a part of this ordinance the same as if fully set forth herein.

Section 3. That the motive power of said railroad shall

That the grantee of said franchise

and his assigns, must, during the life of said franchise, pay to the City of Redlands, two per cent of the gross annual receipts of the person, partnership or corporation to whom the franchise is awarded, arising from its use, operation or possession. No percentage shall be paid for the first five years succeeding the date of the franchise, but thereafter such percentage shall be payable annually; and in the event such payment is not made, said franchise shall be forfeited; provided further, that if the franchise be a renewal of a right already in existence, the payment of said percentage of the gross receipts shall begin at once. In case the franchise granted shall be an extension of an existing system of street railroad, then the gross receipts shall be estimated to be one-half of the proportion of the total gross receipts of said system which the mileage of said extension bears to the total mileage of the whole system; and said estimate shall be conclusive as to the amount of the gross receipts of said extension.

Section 5. This ordinance shall be in force from and after its passage and
