ORDINANCE NO. 340.

An Ordinance fixing a Minimum Standard Quality and Illuminating Power of Gas, and fixing a maximum Gas Rate for gas furnished to the City of Redlands and the Inhabitants thereof, from January 1st, 1904 to December 31st, 1904.

The board of trustees of the city of Redlands do ordain as follows:-

Section 1. The minimum standard quality and illuminating power of gas to be furnished by any person or corporation, to be used in the city of Redlands for any and all
illuminating purposes shall be, and is hereby established
at nineteen (19) candles: said candle power to be determined
by the board of trustees of said city.

January 1st, 1904 and ending December 31st, 1904, the maximum rate of compensation which any person or corporation may charge, collect and receive for furnishing gas to the city of Redlands, or to the inhabitants thereof, for any and all illuminating purposes or heating purposes, is hereby fixed and established at the rate of maximum fitteents for each one thousand cubic feet of gas, and in this proportion for each fractional part thereof; provided that the minimum price for such furnishing of gas for any month shall maximum price for such furnishing of gas for any month shall maximum price for such furnishing of gas for any month

Section 3. It shall be a violation of the provisions of this ordinance, if the minimum standers quality and illuminating power of gas used for illuminating purposes shall be less than the condit power above prescribed, to

KNAMISHZEBER ZOSKAL ALBEZKAK SKOPZPENSE ZO BODE ZO BESKY TABBOKO P if the rate for gas charged or collected, or received for or heating illuminating purposes, as aforesaid, be in excess of the rate or price above specified, and the person or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance is guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be fined in a sum not exceeding \$300.or by imprisonment in the city or county jail for not exceeding ninety days, or by both such fine and imprisonment. Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after January 1st, 1904. mr Fowler President of the board of trustees of said city. Attest:-City Clerk.
