

ORDINANCE No. 383

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDLANDS
relating to use of gasoline engines therein.

The Board of Trustees of the City of Redlands do ordain as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to use, run, or operate, or cause or permit to be used, run, or operated any stationary gasoline engine within **300** feet of any private residence in the City of Redlands, without first obtaining the consent of all persons living or residing within such distance;

Provided that nothing herein contained shall prevent the use or operation of such engines when the exhaust therefrom shall be muffled so as to destroy the noise and report caused from said exhaust.

Sec. 2. Any stationary gasoline engine used, run, or operated in said city as provided in section 1 hereof, without being so muffled is hereby declared to be a public nuisance.

Section 3. Any person guilty of maintaining a public nuisance in violation of this ordinance, or any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of ^a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be fined not exceeding \$ 100.00

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force on and after the first day of April, 1906.
