

ORDINANCE No. 381A

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF REDLANDS fixing a maximum gas rate for gas furnished in the City of Redlands during year 1906.

The Board of Trustees of the City of Redlands do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That for the period commencing January 5th, 1906, and ending December 31, 1906, the maximum rate of compensation which any person or corporation may charge, collect or receive for furnishing gas to the City of Redlands, or to the inhabitants thereof for any and all illuminating or heating purposes is hereby fixed at \$1.00 for each one thousand cubic feet of gas furnished and in this proportion for each fractional part thereof, provided that the minimum price for any month shall not exceed fifty cents, and provided, further, that if gas so furnished shall not be paid for on or before the tenth day of each month for gas furnished during the preceeding month that ten per cent additional may be added thereto.

Section 2. It shall be a violation of this ordinance if the rate charged or collected or received for gas for illuminating or heating purposes be in excess of the rate or price above specified, and any person or corporation violating the provisions of this ordinance or any of them is guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be fined a sum not exceeding \$300.00

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after ^{April} January 7th, 1906.
