

An Ordinance providing for obtaining vital statistics, and prescribing certain health regulations,

The Board of Trustees of the City of Redlands do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Pursuant to the provisions of Section 3061 of the Political Code of the State of California, ~~the following section~~ ^{Section 3024} of said Code is hereby adopted for the regulation as a sanitary regulation in and for ~~Sand~~ ^{Sand} City of Redlands for the period of five years, viz: Section 3024. Physicians and midwives must on or before the fourth day of each month make a return of all births, deaths and the number of still-born children occurring in their practice during the preceding month. In the absence of such attendants the parent must make such report within thirty days after the

birth of the child. Such returns must be made in accordance with rules adopted and upon blanks furnished by the board of health.

Section 2. The Secretary of the Board of Health and City of Richmond shall be the health officer thereof, and the returns required by the provisions of Section 3024 shall be made to him as such health officer.

Section 3. It shall be the duty of the board of health of said city of Richmond to prescribe such regulations as in the judgment of said board shall be necessary, for the prevention of the spread of any contagious or infectious disease in said city including provisions for quarantining infected buildings or localities, and for placing and maintaining signs or notices upon any building or lot of the presence thereof of any contagious or infectious disease or of any

death therefrom. and it shall be the duty of the Secretary of said Board of Health as such health officer as aforesaid, to enforce all such regulations. And no person, other than said Secretary of said Board, shall remove or ~~detach~~ deface any such sign or notice that shall be so placed as aforesaid.

Section 4. Every violation of any provision of this ordinance is hereby declared to be a misdemeanor and shall be punishable by a fine of not less than eight dollars nor more than one hundred dollars or by imprisonment in the city prison for not less than one day nor more than ten days.

Section 5 This ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage.
